



Important Camp Information:

Meals and Snacks:

- Please note that meals and snacks are not included in the registration fee. Parents are responsible for providing nutritious snacks, lunch, and dinner for their children during camp. Don't forget to encourage your child to bring their own water bottle to stay well-hydrated throughout the activities.

Athletic Footwear and Clothing:

- Please make sure your child wears appropriate athletic shoes and sports clothing to ensure safe and comfortable participation in sports activities.
- Children may bring special sports gear depending on the activity (e.g., cleats). Since we may visit the Camille-Vautour School gym, indoor sneakers will be required (you will be notified in advance if needed).
- Children should bring a swimsuit and a towel for water-based activities (you will be notified in advance if this is required).
- We recommend bringing sunscreen, sunglasses, and a hat for our outdoor activities.

Drop-off and Pickup:

- Designated drop-off and pickup location:
 - o Fernand-Léger Outdoor Ice Rink (22 rue des Arts, Saint-Antoine)
- Drop-off time: Between 7:30 AM and 8:00 AM
- Pickup Time: Between 4:00 PM and 4:30 PM
- Please note that children are not permitted to leave the premises at any time unless accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Any other person taking care of the child must be authorized by a parent or guardian (their name must be included on the list of authorized caregivers). This can be noted on the registration page (we only need the name of the person).

Terms and policies – Champdoré Young Champions Camp

General Terms: By registering your child for the summer camp program, you agree to abide by these terms and conditions. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the camp director for assistance.

Registration and Payment:

- Registration: By submitting the registration form and payment, you agree to enroll your child in the summer camp program.
- Payment: Payment must be made in full at the time of registration using one of the available payment methods (cash, check, debit, or credit card).

Cancellation and refund:

- Cancellation Policy: Once the registration form and payment have been received, no cancellations will be accepted or processed. All registrations are considered final and binding upon submission of the registration form and payment.
- Refunds: No refunds will be issued for any reason, including but not limited to schedule changes, conflicts with other activities, illness, or personal reasons. The camp does not offer refunds or credits for missed days or partial attendance.
- If the camp must be canceled due to insufficient enrollment, a full refund will be issued.

Health and safety:

- Medical information: It is the responsibility of the parent or legal guardian to provide accurate medical information about the child, including any allergies, medical conditions, or necessary medications.

Behavioral expectations:

- Respectful Behavior: Children are always expected to treat others with respect and kindness. Harassment, bullying, or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
- Discipline: The camp reserves the right to intervene with campers who engage in behavior that violates camp rules or endangers the safety of others. Disciplinary measures may include removal from the program without a refund.

Terms and policies – Champdoré Young Champions Camp

Liability and Release:

- Acceptance of Risks: Participation in camp activities involves inherent risks, including, but not limited to, accidents, injuries, and exposure to communicable diseases. By enrolling your child in the camp program, you acknowledge and accept these risks.
- Release of Liability: The camp, its staff, volunteers, and affiliates are not liable for any injuries, damages, or losses sustained by campers during camp activities, except in cases of gross negligence or willful misconduct.

Personal effects:

- Lost or Stolen Items: The camp is not responsible for any personal items brought by children that are lost, stolen, or damaged.
- Personal Belongings: Children are responsible for keeping track of their personal belongings and should avoid bringing valuables to camp.
- Electronics: Children are not permitted to use a phone, tablet, or any other electronic device during camp hours.

Communication with parents/guardians:
