

Important camp information :

Meals and snacks :

- Please note that meals and snacks are not included in registration. Parents are responsible for providing nutritious snacks, breakfast and lunch for their children during camp.
- Please remember to encourage your child to bring his or her own water bottle to stay well hydrated throughout the activities.

Sports shoes and clothing :

- Please ensure that your child wears appropriate athletic shoes and sportswear to guarantee safe and comfortable participation in sports activities.
- Children are welcome to bring sports clothing/objects, but the camp is not responsible for this. We will be using the Camille-Vautour school gymnasium, so indoor shoes are strongly recommended.
- Children should have a bathing suit and towel.
- We recommend that you bring sunscreens, sunglasses, bug spray and a cap for our outdoor activities.

Pick-up and Drop-off :

- Designated pick-up and drop-off location :
 - Fernand-Léger outdoor rink (22 rue des Arts, Saint-Antoine)
- Designated drop-off time : Between 7:30 a.m. and 8:00 a.m.
- Designated pick-up time : Between 4:00 p.m. and 4:30 p.m.
- Please note that children are not allowed to leave the premises at any time, unless accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Terms and Conditions : By registering your child in the summer camp program, you agree to abide by these terms and conditions. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the camp director for assistance.

Registration and payment:

- Registration : By submitting the registration form and payment, you agree to enroll your child in the summer camp program.
- Payment: Payment must be made in full at the time of registration. (cash, cheque, debit and credit)

Cancellations and refunds:

- Cancellation policy: Once the registration form and payment have been received, no cancellations will be accepted or processed. All registrations are considered final and binding upon submission of registration form and payment.
- Refunds: No refunds will be issued for any reason, including but not limited to programming loads, conflicts with other activities, illness or personal reasons. The camp does not offer refunds or credits for missed days or partial attendance.
- If the camp has to be cancelled due to insufficient registrations, a full refund will be issued.

Health and safety:

- Medical information: it is the responsibility of the parent or legal guardian to provide accurate medical information about the child, including any allergies, medical conditions or medication required.

Behavioral expectations :

- Respectful behavior: Children are always expected to treat others with respect and kindness. Harassment, bullying or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
- Discipline: The camp reserves the right to discipline campers who engage in violent behavior against camp rules or endangering the safety of others. Disciplinary action may include dismissal from the program without refund.



Liability and Release :

- Assumption of risk: Participation in camp activities involves inherent risks, including but not limited to accidents, injuries and exposure to communicable diseases. By registering your child in the camp program, you acknowledge and accept these risks.
- Disclaimer: The camp, its staff, volunteers and affiliates are not liable for any injury, damage or loss sustained by campers during camp activities, except in cases of gross negligence or willful misconduct.

Personal effects :

- Lost or stolen items : The camp is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged personal items brought by children.
- Personal property: Children are responsible for keeping track of their personal belongings and should avoid bringing valuables to camp.
- Electronics: Children may not use phones, iPads or other electronics during camp hours.

Parental communication :

- Communication channels: The camp will communicate important information to parents/guardians via email, Facebook group or other designated channels.
- Parental involvement: Parents/guardians are encouraged to stay informed about camp activities and events, and to communicate any concerns or questions with camp staff.
